YOU'RE INVITED TO A NEIGHBORHOOD MEETING FOR THE 2025 STREET AND UTILITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

A plan review Open House for the proposed 2025 Street and Utility Improvement Project will be held on **Wednesday, January 8, 2025, from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.** in the New Prague City Hall. This is an "Open House", so come when you can, and stay as long as you'd like. This open house is intended to give residents and the public an opportunity to meet with city staff and the engineering designers from SEH to look over the construction plans and review the work proposed on the project. This is also the time to go over questions one might have about the project before construction begins.

The project will be advertised in February for review by area contractors who will consider bidding on the project. The project is expected to bid on February 21, 2025, with the City Council considering an award of the bids at their March 3, 2025, meeting. Construction is expected to begin sometime in April. Once the contractor is determined, a better schedule will be provided. Additional information about the construction process will also be mailed out to affected residents before construction begins.

The streets included in the proposed project include:

- Lincoln Avenue N from Main Street to 5th Street NE (full reconstruction)
- Pershing Avenue N from Main Street to 5th Street NE (full reconstruction)
- 1st Street NE from Columbus Avenue N to Pershing Avenue N (full reconstruction)
- 2nd Street NE from Columbus Avenue N to Lyndale Avenue N (sidewalk only construction)
- 12th Avenue SE from Tikalsky St SE to 9th street SE (sidewalk only construction)
- Alleys located between Columbus Avenue N and Lincoln Avenue N, north of Main Street E (pavement replacement)

On full reconstruction streets, the project includes sanitary sewer, water main, storm sewer, concrete curb and gutter, aggregate base, bituminous street surfacing, concrete walk, driveways, turf restoration, and miscellaneous items required to properly complete the improvements.

On sidewalk only streets, the project includes construction of sidewalk on existing streets with related grading, driveway replacement, and partial curb and gutter replacement.
