The project has been awarded to Holtmeier Construction, Inc., of Mankato, Minnesota. A preconstruction meeting with the contractor will be held on March 27th where a full schedule will be provided. The contractor currently expects to start mobilizing equipment and installing temporary water service the week of March 31st to allow pavement removals to begin as soon as April 7th. The work will be phased and improvements staged to minimize disruption to access where possible. Private utility work/relocations will likely be starting soon to relocate or replace those facilities (gas mains, underground electric lines, fiber optic, and telephone cables).

A Construction Open House is scheduled for April 2, 2025 (see next page). More details regarding the construction schedule and phasing will be known by that time. John Voigt with SEH will be on site providing construction observation and will be the first point of contact to answer any questions you may have during construction of the project; his contact information is shown on the left side of this sheet.

Survey stakes will be placed on the construction site. **Destruction or alteration of survey stakes results in slowing the work and additional cost to the City.**

This is the time to remind everyone that anything within the public right-of-way could be in jeopardy of being damaged and/or removed. This includes landscaping, irrigation or pet containment systems, etc. Those systems are considered "private" facilities. Locating them and marking them in and near the right-of-way is the property owner's responsibility. It would be helpful for those of you who have irrigation or pet containment systems to contact John so that we are made aware of them. **There is a high likelihood that items within the right of way, including irrigation and landscaping will be damaged or otherwise affected by construction activities. Repairs to these items are the responsibility of the property owner.**

A construction Open House for the 2025 Street and Utility Improvement Project will held on **Wednesday, April 2, 2025, from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.** in the New Prague City Hall. This is an "Open House", so come when you can, and stay as long as you'd like. This open house is intended to give residents and the public an opportunity to meet with city staff and the engineering designers from SEH to look over the construction plans and the preliminary construction schedule. This is also the time to go over questions one might have about the project before construction begins.

The project has been awarded to Holtmeier Construction, Inc., of Mankato, Minnesota. A preconstruction meeting with the contractor will be held on March 27th, and the Project is anticipated to begin in early April with substantial completion in October. The construction will be staged to minimize disruption to access. Private utility work/relocations will likely be starting soon to relocate or replace those facilities (gas mains, underground electric lines, fiber optic, and telephone cables). CenterPoint Energy will be constructing a new gas main on Lincoln Avenue N, Pershing Avenue N, and 1st Street NE and providing new service connections.

As work progresses, we will provide regular Project Updates to keep you informed during the project.
