Concrete crews installed curb and gutter, driveways, and sidewalk throughout many project area streets this week. Some areas have not yet been finished but will be completed later. Street crews are backfilling the boulevards with topsoil. Paving of Lexington Avenue N and 1st Street SE is currently scheduled for Wednesday next week.

Utility crews will complete installation of sanitary sewer and water main on 6th Street NE next week. They will then begin installation of sanitary and water services likely toward the end of the week or early the following week. The intersection with Pershing Avenue N will be temporarily restored as gravel for several weeks and paved with 6th Street NE.

Utility work will likely go through the end of the month before completion. Street restoration crews will follow. The long term schedule expects paving of 6th Street NE around the middle of October.

This is the time to remind everyone that anything within the public right-of-way could be in jeopardy of being damaged and/or removed. This includes landscaping, irrigation or pet containment systems, etc. Those systems are considered "private" facilities. Locating them and marking them in and near the right-of-way is the property owner's responsibility. **There is a high likelihood that items within the right of way, including irrigation and landscaping, will be damaged or otherwise affected by construction activities. Repairs to these items are the responsibility of the property owner.**
