Holtmeier Construction has completed the installation of most water main on Lincoln Avenue N between Main Street and 2nd Street NE. They have started sanitary sewer main installation from Main Street and are working their way north. Crews will finish the installation of sanitary sewer main next week and also begin installation of storm sewer, sanitary sewer services, and water services. A second pipe crew is expected to arrive on Monday next week. All work is expected to remain south of 2nd Street NE on Lincoln Avenue N. As water mains and services are finished and tested, temporary water services will be removed.

CenterPoint Energy will continue its installation of new gas mains and services in the area. Please note that CenterPoint will be in contact with residents as gas service is replaced.

With construction occurring, access to properties from the street will be limited and we ask that you use alleys for access where available or park on side streets.

Survey stakes will be placed on the construction site. **Destruction or alteration of survey stakes results in slowing the work and additional cost to the City.**

This is the time to remind everyone that anything within the public right-of-way could be in jeopardy of being damaged and/or removed. This includes landscaping, irrigation or pet containment systems, etc. Those systems are considered "private" facilities. Locating them and marking them in and near the right-of-way is the property owner's responsibility. It would be helpful for those of you who have irrigation or pet containment systems to contact John so that we are made aware of them. **There is a high likelihood that items within the right of way, including irrigation and landscaping will be damaged or otherwise affected by construction activities. Repairs to these items are the responsibility of the property owner.**
